The Harnham Water Meadows Trust is a charity whose role is to maintain and preserve the beautiful water meadows alongside the Town Path in Salisbury.

We are looking for some additional members to join our Education team. You may have retired from teaching, be working part-time in a teaching or support role, or be seeking wider experience in the teaching and learning sector. It is important that you have some experience of teaching or supporting children in Key Stages 1 and 2.

Throughout the year we encourage local schools to visit the meadows as part of their Key Stage 1 and 2 curriculum studies. During these visits, we work with the teachers to plan and deliver sessions that meet their curriculum aims. We have excellent resources which include a classroom in Rose Cottage with an interactive whiteboard, and equipment for pond-dipping etc. We enjoy wonderful walks together in the meadows, along the rivers and streams, and have the privilege of enjoying views of Salisbury and the Cathedral that people rarely see.

We host about 20 school visits a year between March and October and we can be very flexible to accommodate your commitments. Each visit lasts about two to three hours in the mornings. We would not expect you to join all of these visits. We will provide full training and support, ensuring that you gain the required knowledge and understanding of these wonderful water meadows.
